## NOTICE – CITY OF READING COMMUTER EMPLOYEES 2022 LOCAL EARNED INCOME TAX RETURN

## FOR TAXPAYERS RESIDING WITHIN THE BERKS COUNTY TAX COLLECTION DISTRICT WHO FILE A LOCAL EARNED INCOME TAX RETURN WITH BERKS EARNED INCOME TAX BUREAU

Effective July 1, 2022, the City of Reading removed the additional 0.3% non-resident EIT assessed against non-resident commuter taxpayers. A non-resident commuter taxpayer is an employee who commutes to and works for an employer in the City of Reading – but who lives outside of the City of Reading.

As a result, commuter taxpayer wages and tax liability calculations for the 2022 Local Earned Income Tax return must be separated for the change in rate as of July 1, 2022. Non-resident commuter taxpayers will be **unable** to file their 2022 Local Earned Income Tax return electronically. These commuters must file their 2022 Local Earned Income Tax Return using the form available on our website. As a courtesy, a copy of the return is attached to this letter.
